EYM PRESS RELEASE, Friday, 28th July, 2006.

Frohnleiten, Styria, Austria. Perfect, if hot, conditions greeted the players on the second day of the European Young Masters (EYM).

Germany made the most of it with three players now in the top three placings in both the girls and the boys. Saskia Hausladen has taken the equal lead with Carlota Ciganda (Spain) and Carly Booth (Scotland) following an equal best round of the day, 71. All three are on 143. Maximilian Kiefer had the low round of the day in the boys (68) and lies two behind Pedro Figueiredo of Portugal, who followed his first round 66 with a solid twounder par 70.

Germany now has a commanding lead in the Nations' Cup. Their 420 total (-12) puts them 13 ahead of France (433) and 15 ahead of third-placed Spain. Scotland, Ireland, Portugal, Norway and Italy have not lost touch and could still finish in the top three.

Tomorrow's final round should prove exciting with seven girls and seven boys within six shots of the lead in their respective competitions.
