Andreas Pallauf returns as captain to lead the Continent of Europe Jacques L glise Trophy (JLT) team to play against Great Britain and Ireland (GB&I) at Kingsbarns Golf Links, St Andrews.

Some of last year's young team also return, including Max Kieffer, Matteo Manassero and Cristiano Terragni. They will be joined by three Scandinavian players, whose national boys' teams have proven exceptionally strong in the 2008 European Boys' Team Championship won by Sweden over Norway. Norway are the current world junior team champions.

The other three players making their debut are Romain Wattel, winner of the Coupe Frayssineau-Mouchy (French Stroke Play) and two Spanish players, both hailing from the same golf club. Carlos Pigem is fast ascending the world amateur golf rankings and has been one of the most consistent performers in Spain. He won the Canarias Amateur and Andalucia Cup this year. Emilio Cuartero is the holding Boys' Amateur Champion to be defended this week.

The continental team look forward to improving on last year's narrow loss to GB&I.
