

European Amateur Golf Ranking 2013



Congratulations to the Top Ranked Players in the European Amateur Golf Ranking 2013. Final results for 2013 (as of 10 September) were:

1	Matthew Fitzpatrick	England	1405.69 pts
2	Max Orrin	England	1231.72 pts
3	Sebastian Cappelen	Denmark	1203.16 pts

Matthew Fitzpatrick (ENG), from Hallamshire Golf Club in Sheffield, started his rise to the summit of the World and European Amateur Golf Ranking at the end of 2012 when he won The Boys Amateur Championship. In 2013, he won the Selborne Salver and played his way into the 2013 Open Championship in Local Final Qualifying at Gullane. Matthew excelled at Muirfield where he placed joint 44th, picking up the silver medal as leading amateur. He carried on early August by finishing runner-up at the English Amateur and finally won the U.S. Amateur Championship at the Country Club in Brookline, Massachusetts. He will play college golf next year, discover the Masters and enjoy another Open Championship at Royal Liverpool.

Max Orrin (ENG) had a succession of good performances throughout the summer. He won the South East of England Links Championship, Lagonda Trophy in May and placed joint second at the St Andrews Links Trophy. Max then reached the semi-finals of The Amateur and English Amateur Championships. He was finally selected in the Great Britain & Ireland Team for the Walker Cup played at the National Golf Links of America. Max will continue his golfing career in the professional ranks.

Sebastian Cappelen from Odense, Denmark, has recorded most of his successes playing college golf, in which he recorded three victories. He won the Patriot All-America at the end of 2012 and the SEC Championship in April. He also reached the semi-finals at the Western Amateur Championship. Sebastian furthermore also three-time Palmer Cup participant for Team Europe.
